

## Airport Transportation – Links and Information

**Cab Service:** <http://www.sanantonio.gov/SAT/GroundTransportation/Taxi.aspx>

Approximate fee is \$25 to \$29. Up to six can share as long as baggage will fit. Travel time is approximately **15-minutes**.

**Airport Shuttle:** <http://www.sanantonio.gov/SAT/GroundTransportation/Shuttle.aspx>

GO Airport Shuttle is San Antonio International Airport's authorized and single shared- ride shuttle service. Shuttles depart from 7 a.m. to 1:30 a.m. daily to downtown hotels every 15 minutes. Passengers may purchase tickets at the airport's baggage claim area. Travel time from Airport to the Hotel is apx. **One-Hour**.

\$19.00 per person to downtown hotels or \$38.00 for a round trip ticket. Book online and receive an additional discounts. Booking two passengers is more cost effective than one round trip. On line link: <https://www.citytoursinc.com/reservations>

**Note: It looks like by adjusting pickup times, you can save about \$8.00 on a roundtrip.**

**City Bus Service:** [www.viainfo.net](http://www.viainfo.net) 1.866.362.2020. VIA Metropolitan Transit is San Antonio's public transportation agency offering service throughout the city including streetcar service within the downtown area. Route 5 operates between the airport and downtown. Weekdays the service is every 20 minutes (rush-hour) and every 30 minutes (non rush-hour). Weekends it's every 30 minutes. Travel time is approximately **40 minutes**. Cost is **\$1.20** per person, **\$0.60** for persons over 62. **Correct change is required.**

**To get downtown from the airport:**

- Go to the Lower Roadway (Arrivals/Baggage Level in Terminal A and B), across the marked crosswalk to the outer curb.
- VIA's stop will be located on the far West end of Terminal B, clearly marked.
- You will catch **VIA bus route 5**, which operates everyday, and can get to beautiful downtown San Antonio in **about 40 minutes**.
  - Note: There is a stop on St. Mary's Street (the hotel's street) between Travis and Houston which is about one block from the hotel. The hotel is located on St. Mary's about ½ block beyond the Houston Street intersection.

Once in the downtown area, VIA's streetcar service offers stops to or near most hotels, restaurants, the convention center and many visitors hot spots.

For added convenience, VIA offers \$4 Day Pass for purchase on online and in advance of your trip. A Day Pass is good for unlimited rides on all regular bus and streetcar service for the one day indicated on the pass. The Day Pass will be activated the first time boarding the bus or streetcar.
