The National Coastwatch Institution is a voluntary organisation set up in 1994 to restore a visual watch along UK shores after many small coastguard stations closed. Each station is manned by a team of fully trained volunteers, who keep a daylight watch for up to 365 days.

There will be refreshments on arrival at Fort Blockhouse and then an illustrated talk by the Station Manager Rob Herron, followed by a chance to go into the Station. You will also be able to visit the nearby Submarine Memorial Chapel. This visit involves steps and a ladder (with proper steps).
